Teachers are extremely happy with the work that is being submitted, and it is clear learning is continuing, despite of the difficult situations. Here are a few of your comments from this week:

You said	Our response
Will there be live lessons?	Yes! There are two daily live sessions scheduled to start this week: one in the morning to explain the day's tasks, and one in the afternoon to share a class novel/story.
We are sharing devices so our children sometimes find it difficult to get everything done	Create a 'device' timetable at home so everyone gets a chance to access their learning. We have lengthened the submission dates for tasks so it is easier to manage sharing devices
We are getting lots of phone calls. Will this continue?	Your child's class teacher will be contacting your child to ensure they understand their home learning or to read with them over the phone. They may want to speak to parents if work is not being completed. Logging in to the live sessions will reduce the number of calls needed

Please ensure that your child(ren) are able to join the live sessions each day as this will not only help them to understand what is required of them during the day as well as put a routine to the day. It will also be good for the children to make virtual contact with their teacher and friends, which will be good for their well-being.

Live sessions today were successful with a number of children logging in. Please make every effort for your child to log in each day. They can log in on a smart phone as well as a laptop or tablet. If you are having issues with your child logging in to the live lessons, please let us know.
