Thank you for your continued understanding as we try to respond to the rapidly changing circumstances that we, as a country, are facing.

Going forward we are altering how we resolve the issue with respect to Free School Meals for our Primary and Secondary academies.

Tomorrow, we will be providing vouchers for supermarkets from a site called Wonde for those parents & carers that would normally receive free school meal provision for their child.

On Friday 27th March, those eligible will receive a text or email sending you to a site that will require you to select a preferred supermarket. Once you have selected your preferred option you will, on the same day, receive an e-voucher that you will be able to use in your preferred supermarket. Initially this will be for use during the following period

Monday 30th March – Friday 3rd April – Voucher of £15

We will be in touch with you regarding future plans.



These measures will allow you to comply with the government's latest guidance for social distancing and isolation.

When the parent receives the text message or email, they simply:

1. Click on the link
2. Select their desired supermarket
3. A voucher is then shown which can be taken in-store or online
