Dear Parents / Carers,

I hope you and your family are keeping safe and well and you are looking forward to sending your children back to school. We are very much looking forward to seeing them all again.... We really have missed them!

We have made great efforts to make sure the school is as safe as possible and so have had to make a few changes including the staggered start at the beginning and the end of the day, which we shared with you at the end of term. We have included a reminder is at the bottom of this letter. We have also staggered lunchtime and playtimes so that groups of children do not mix.

Please help us to keep everyone in our school and community safe by:

- **Following the one- way system** in and out of school which is clear signposted. All children will enter the school site via the gate by the nursery entrance, exit from the site is via the gate by the drive. Staff will guide the children to the door they need to use to enter the building and signposts will show where children can be collected at the end of school.
- **Arriving on time in the morning and collecting on time at the end of the day.** We need to limit the number of adults on site at any one time. Where there are children who need to be collected at different times you may collect all your children at the time the last child finishes.
- Limit **one adult** to drop off and collect the children.
- Following the government guidance on **face covering** and **social distancing** whilst on school premises

If you need to speak to a member of staff please call the school to arrange a convenient time for a telephone call. At this time, we need to limit face to face contact as much as possible.

It is important that if your children have recently visited one of the countries which require them **quarantine** please adhere to it and **let the school know**. Please check the government website for the most up to date list of countries which require the children to quarantine. If anyone in your household show signs of Covid then please get tested and self-isolate if required. Please let the school know if anyone in your household has a positive test.

**We are unable to provide breakfast club and afterschool clubs** until further notice as this would result in the mixing of bubbles.

The children will need to attend school in school uniform other than days timetabled for PE where the children will need to come to school in their PE kits.
