


Nursery Week 4 – Food

Weekly Maths Tasks

- **One potato two potato** – Sing the song, One potato two potato Can you use real potatoes to count with whilst singing the song? Stick tooth picks in them to represent each number.
- **Challenge** – 7 potatoes ... How many more potatoes do you need to make 10?
- **Fruit and Vegetable shop** – Make a fruit and veg shop. Ask your family to come and buy some. How much money did you make?
- **Number formation** – Write price labels for your fruit and vegetables. e.g. 1p 2p 3p 4p 5p
- **Potato print patterns** – Cut a potato in half. Paint each half a different colour. Use the halves to print a repeated pattern 
- **Family walk number challenge** – What different food shops do you pass on your daily walk? Count how many you see or make a tally of the number of shops. What different foods do these shops sell?

Questions to ask about the story:

What is a vegetable? What was small and round and green? What did the evil pea do to the vegetables? Who saved the vegetables? How did Supertato catch the pea? What vegetables are there in your freezer?

Learning project

The project this week gives opportunities for your child to learn more about different types of food.

- **Superhero Potato** - Make your very own Supertato. Copy Supertato from the book or make up your own. What will they need? A cape, a mask and a super hero costume. What colours will you use?
- **Small world vegetables** - Draw faces onto real vegetables and use them act out the Supertato story.
- **Frozen Vegetables** – Using plastic tubs with water in freeze different vegetables (The Evil Pea). Can you remember how we made the water freeze? Where do you need to put it? Once frozen try and break the vegetable out of their frozen cages. Think of different ways to get them out.
- **Hot and cold treats** –

- **Arcimboldo** – Look at the artist Arcimboldo. Can you make a face using fruit and vegetables? Take a photo of your portrait.

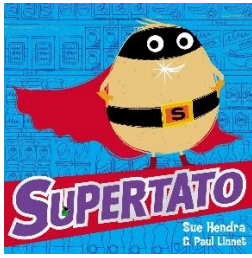
Email
